Family day

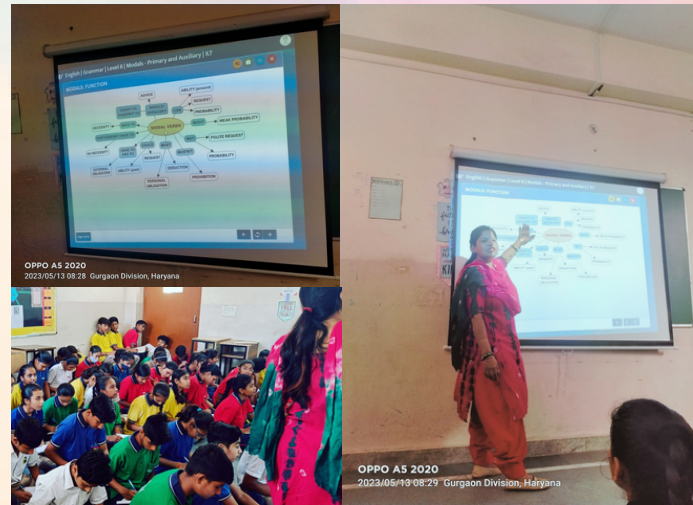
Family Day at Laburnum Public School went beyond just entertainment. The event aimed to strengthen the bond between the school, students, and families by promoting open communication and understanding.

WORKSHOPS
