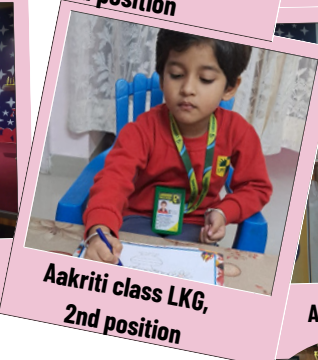

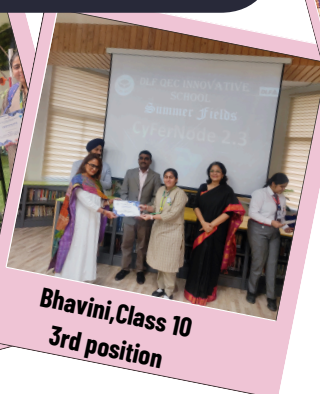

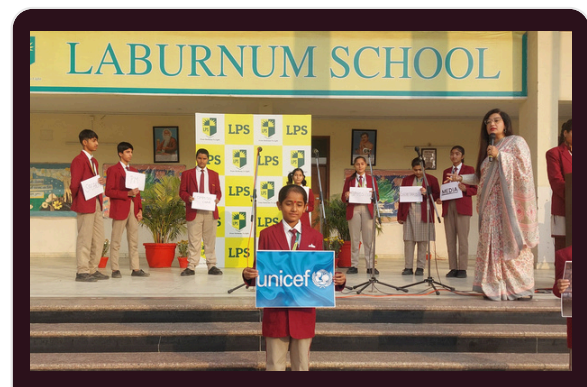
### Farmers' Day

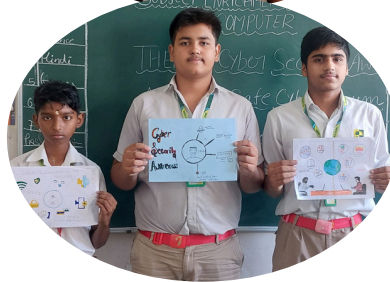
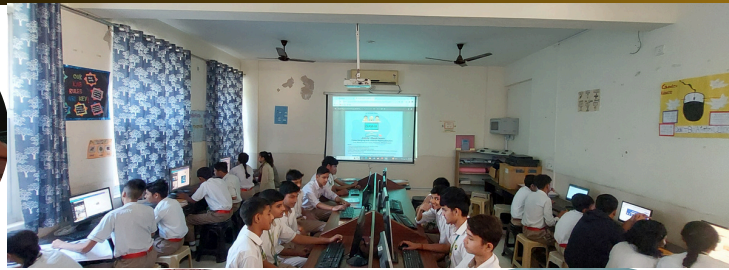

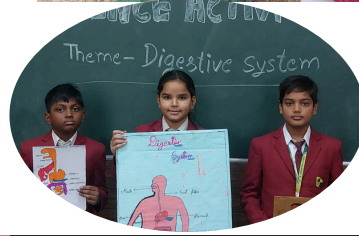
## Subject Enrichment Activity
