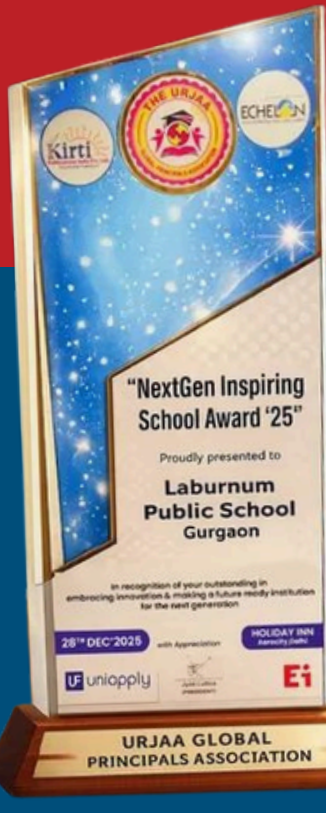

## SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES

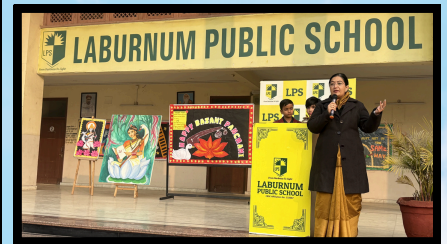
### FELICITATION CEREMONY

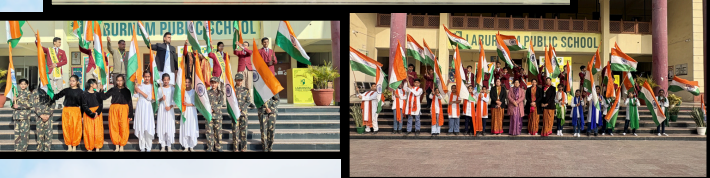
### VASANT PANCHAMI

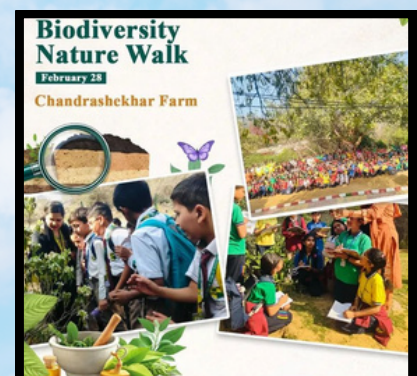
### PARENT TEACHER INTERACTION

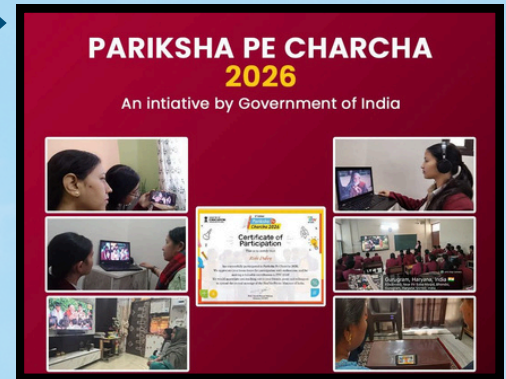

## WORKSHOPS

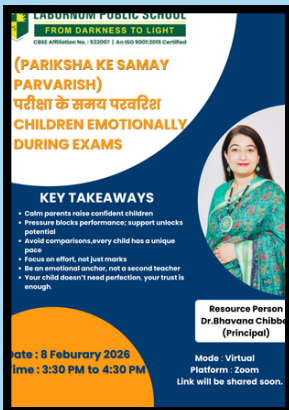
### PARIKSHA PE CHARCHA

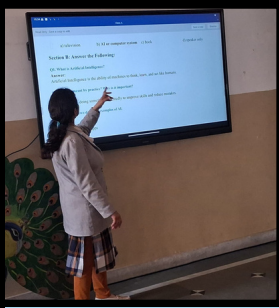

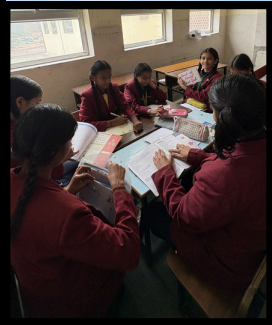

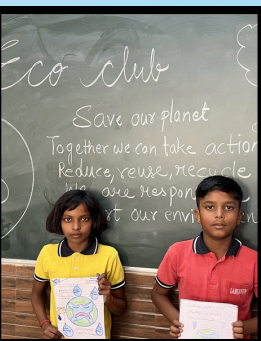
