Greetings!

We are excited to announce an engaging and creative **Inter-House Competition – “Mic Masters: House Podcast / Talk Show”**. This activity aims to enhance students’ communication skills, confidence, creativity, and teamwork through a fun and interactive platform. As per CBSE guidelines, students from classes III -XI will take part in various activities based on various themes.

About the Activity:

Students will present a live podcast based on the given topic. Each house will have a host and 5 speakers (per team) & audience who will discuss the topic, share ideas, and answer questions. The presentation will include introduction, discussion, audience interaction, and conclusion.

Students will present a live talk show or podcast in teams. Each house will choose a topic and perform like a real show with a host, guests, and audience interaction.

The **Preliminary round** will be held on **6th May, 2026** and participation is mandatory for every student. Rest final round dates will be shared with you.

The details of activities are as follow:

S.No.	Category	Topics	Activities
1.	Class – III- V	➤ If Animals Could Talk OR ➤ School Without Homework	Students will perform a simple talk show where the host asks questions and students share their ideas in a creative way.
2.	Class – VI- VII	➤ Mobile Phones: Boon or Bane OR ➤ Friendship vs social media	Students will conduct a talk show discussing both sides of the topic with examples and audience questions
3.	Class – IX- XI	➤ AI: Helper or Threat OR ➤ Success vs Happiness	Students will present a structured podcast with discussion, arguments, real-life examples, and logical conclusions

Team Composition (Per House)

- 1 Host
- 5 – Guests (per team)
- Rest students Audience

Rules & Guidelines for class III – VIII:

- Each team will get 20 minutes for their presentation.
- All participants must be in proper house uniform.
- Use simple language and short sentences

- Host will ask basic and easy questions
- Minimum 2–3 students must speak at a time.
- No memorization pressure – speak naturally.
- **One audience question is compulsory**
- Avoid interrupting while others are speaking

Example: Acting like animals talking or students sharing ideas

Rules & Guidelines for class IX – XI:

- Each team will get 20 minutes for their presentation.
- All participants must be in proper house uniform.
- Critical Thinking & Presentation
- Content should include facts, examples, or real-life situations
- Discussion must be well-structured (intro–discussion–conclusion)
- Students should show logical reasoning and opinions
- **One twist/surprise question may be asked by judges(audience)**
- Avoid repetition; maintain flow and coordination

Example: Debate-style discussion on AI with solutions.

Judging Criteria for class III- XI:

- **Content & Relevance-** Ideas are clear, meaningful, and related to the topic
- **Communication Skills-** Clarity of speech, pronunciation, fluency, confidence
- **Creativity & Presentation-** Innovative style, role play, engaging format
- **Team Coordination-** Equal participation, smooth flow, teamwork
- **Confidence & Stage Presence-** Body language, eye contact, overall impact

We expect all students to participate with enthusiasm and make this initiative a grant success.
